An update from your Stewardship Committee We've got some exciting news to share!

St. Stephen's takes another step into the digital arena. We now offer giving by text or mobile app from your smart phone.



In less time than it takes to write a check, you can make weekly offerings and respond to special appeals by sending a text message. Vanco's Give+ Text is not meant to replace other donation methods. Rather, it offers another convenient way to fulfill your stewardship commitments. Normal text messaging fees from your cell phone carrier may apply.

Here's some answers to common questions:

How do I know when my donations are processed?

You will receive immediate confirmation via text that your donation was received. After the text donation has been processed, it will appear on your credit card statement.

Are contributions set at a fixed dollar amount?


No. You control what amount you want to give - each time.

Are text donations ever charged to a member's mobile phone bill?

No. Donations are processed using the payment method you specify in your online profile (credit or debit card). Phone carriers handle only the text message, never financial information.

Can I set up a recurring donation by text?

Yes. You can text "Repeat" after you've made a donation to make it recurring. You can also text "Schedule" to set up a recurring donation.



Quick Guide pictured on the left shows actual screenshots that you will see on your phone.

Step One:

Key in St Stephen's 10digit Text phone number: 844-907-2702

Step Two:

Enter dollar amount you wish to donate, then press send. The example to the left shows a donation of \$10.

Step Three:

You will receive a registration link. Click link and enter your information. Tap "Process"

Step Four:

After registration is complete You will receive both a text and verification email.

Want to try out the Mobile App?

Download the Vanco Give+ app (pictured to the left). It will ask you for the church's name or zip code. Easier to find by zip code (55118) you can also use St. Stephen's Lutheran which will give you a listing of several churches. Then follow the prompts to create an account.
